California, mendocino (2011) - blackberry, plum, vanilla, chocolate & lingering pomegranate
- ☛ CONO SUR ORGANIC PINOT NOIR
Chile, central valley (2011) - organic, cherries & berries, toast, soft tannins
- ☛ SALADINI PILASTRI
Italy, Marches (2011) - organic, nicely balanced vino rosso made with sangiovese & montepulciano grapes
- ☛ OKO MALBEC
Argentina, mendoza (2011) - organic; plum, cherry & chocolate laced with spice, lingers

WHITES

- ☛ TOURAINE SAUVIGNON BLANC
France, Loire Valley-Touraine (2011) - melon, grapefruit, spice; aromatic & round with a lovely finish
- BIANCHI NEW AGE
Argentina (2012) - malvasia & sauvignon blanc blend; sweet, fruity, floral
- ☛ TENUTA SANT'ANTONIO SCAIA
Italy, Veneto (2012) - garganega and chardonnay blend; crisp, layered minerals, mango, grapefruit
- RIONDO PROSECCO
Italy, Veneto (2011) - excellent aperitif; bright, crisp fruit, hints of pear & toast
